AIRPORT INFORMATION

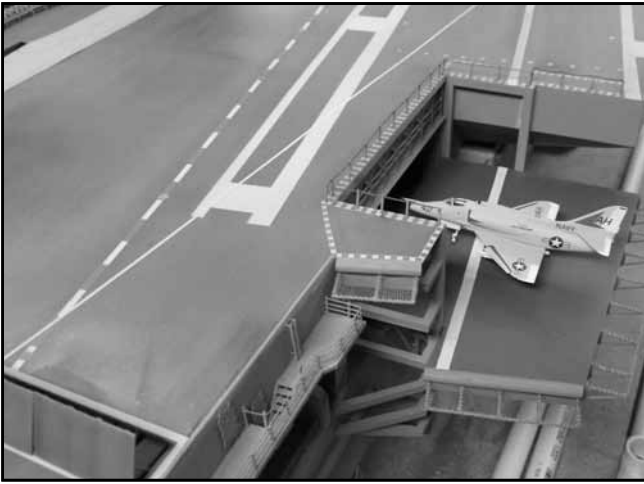
Unfortunately United Airlines commercial air
service into the Topeka Regional Airport from
Chicago has now been cancelled, as of the be-
ginning of September 2014. The best way to
reach Topeka is to fly into Kansas City airport.

The Capitol Plaza Hotel is 74 miles from
the Kansas City Airport and 67 miles from
the Manhattan, Kansas Regional Airport.
Both airports have car rental availability.

KCI Road Runner shuttle service from the Kansas City
airport to the Topeka hotel: \$58 (rates subject to change)

Directions from Kansas City Airport:
Take I-29 North approximately 2 miles to I-435 South. Trav-
el on I-435 South 15 miles to I-70 West (toll road). Take
I-70 West 45 miles to the Topeka Exit (Exit363)/Adams St.
Turn left onto Adams St. and then turn right off Adams St.
at 15th Street. When the street forks, stay on the left hand
side and merge on to 17th St. (15th St. goes right). The
Capitol Plaza Hotel is on the left corner of Topeka Blvd
and 17th St. Turn left on Topeka Blvd. and right into the
Capitol Plaza Hotel/Kansas Expocentre main entrance.

The Final Date for registration is Monday September 1st.

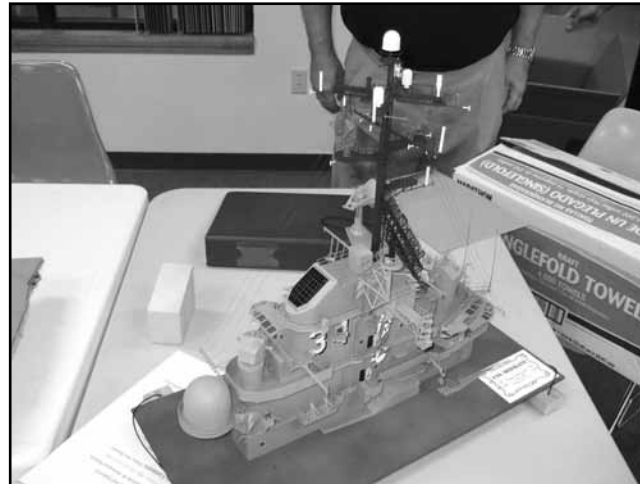
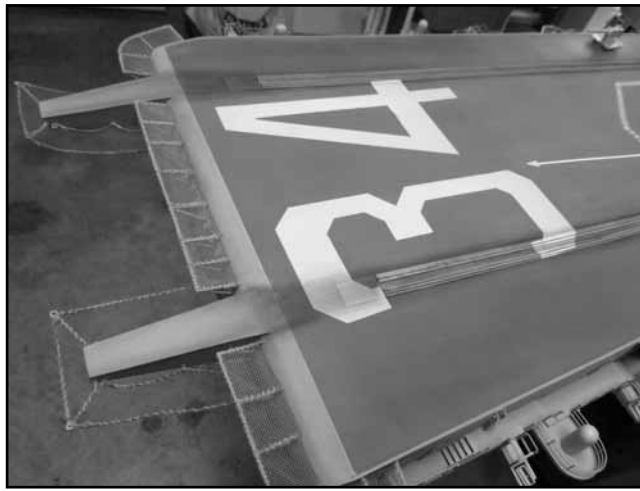
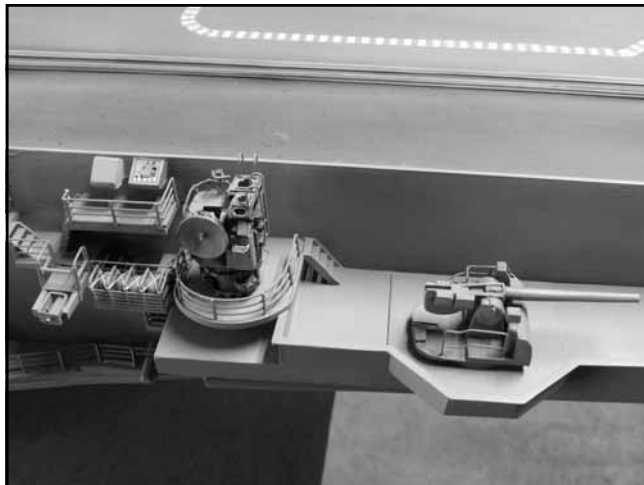


Three Master Modelers have been working on the USS Oriskany model since March 2007 for the Combat Air Museum exhibit:

Larry Todd, working from a rough wood hull, re-dimensioned to exact measurements, has built a new flight deck, along with all the hull details, deck crew, tilly and lifeboats, in exacting detail.

Darren Roberts built the air wing of 49 scale models, with the correct Squadron and Bureau Numbers of the aircraft aboard USS Oriskany at the time of the 1966 fire (bottom right).
