

Frequently Asked Questions: The Answers

Registration Process :

- How do I register for the car show?

- Scroll up the page and click on the link “Online Pre-Registration”

- What are the registration fees?

- \$20

I don't want to pay online, how do I pre-register? You can click on the link “Printable Pre-Registration Form” and then print and submit the completed application and fee to the Combat Air Museum (address info is listed on the application).

Event Details:

- When and where is the car show taking place?

- Sunday October 4th from 10 am until 2 pm at the Combat Air Museum on the Topeka Regional Airport grounds – 7016 SE Forbes Ave., Topeka

- What time should I arrive?

- There are two entry gates (click and view the downloadable map)
The north gate will open at 8 am for VIPs and Preregistered vehicles only
The south gate will open at 9 am for all other unregistered vehicles.
The south entry gate will be manned and open until 11:00 am.
- *If it rains, is the show canceled?* No, the show will go on! This is a rain or shine event!
- *If I have a group of cars coming, can I hold spots for them?* No, but we have no problem with you pulling to the side and waiting for them. We will get you parked together, once you are all there.
- *Is it OK to bring in outside food and drinks?* Yes, but we encourage you to buy from the vendors of the show. Portions of those proceeds go to the museum and it supports local businesses.
- *Can I leave at anytime?* Yes, please get with a volunteer of the show, and we will get you out safe and in the right direction. REMEMBER, THIS IS AN ACTIVE BASE!
- *What if I have family and friends coming separately, with no show car?* They can go through the entrance of the museum and pay an admission fee to the museum. There are discounted admission fees for the show.

Merchandise:

- *Can I purchase a custom event shirt?* Yes, there will be a staffed area near the registration table
- *What sizes are available and how much do they cost?* Sizes are Small through 4XL and begin at \$25 (quantities are limited)

Rules and Guidelines:

- *What are the rules for participating in the car show?* No loud music as a DJ will be providing the music and periodic announcements. No speeding on the air base, keep at 10mph. Absolutely no burnouts! Stay within the barricaded areas at all times. Be respectful to all attendees and volunteers.
- *Are there any restrictions on vehicle modifications?* No

Airport Rules:

For the safety and security of everyone, please be advised that the following items are strictly prohibited on the flight line side of the fence:

- Smoking
- Alcohol
- Drones
- Edged Weapons (including knives of any size)
- Firearms
